Guidelines for Presenters

Guidance for Oral Presentations – In Person

- Each presenter will have 25 minutes available, and we suggest a presentation of 15 minutes with 10 minutes for Q&A.
- Most sessions will include three oral presentations and last for 75 minutes.
- Please bring your presentation slides, on a USB stick, to the room your presentation is scheduled to take place in, **before 8.45am** on the day of your presentation. You will then be able to save your presentation onto a conference laptop. For any Mac users please be aware that the laptops at the conference venue are Windows laptops.
- You are also invited to make a pre-record of your presentation, to be uploaded onto the online conference portal. This will be available to conference delegates only, after the conference ends. By submitting a recording, your presentation will be available to people attending online and also by people attending in-person who were not able to make your session. If you would like to make a recording please email <u>conference@ethox.ox.ac.uk</u> for more details.

Guidance for Oral Presentations – Online

- Each presenter will have 25 minutes available, and we suggest a presentation of 15 minutes with 10 minutes for Q&A.
- Most sessions will include three oral presentations and last for 75 minutes. The sessions will be organised to work for a combination of time zones of the presenters.
- Online sessions will be delivered via zoom the zoom link for your session will emailed to you one week before the conference.
- You will be responsible for sharing your presentation, via the share screen function on Zoom. If you are concerned about internet access and would like to pre-record your presentation, please get in touch ASAP.
- Online sessions will be recorded and will be added to the conference online portal viewable to conference delegates only. If you would not like the recording of your presentation shared on the conference online portal please email <u>conference@ethox.ox.ac.uk</u> to advise us.

Guidance for Lightning Talk Presenters

- These interactive sessions will last 75 minutes and will feature up to 5 individual lightning talks, followed by a facilitated Q&A/discussion with presenters and session participants.
- Each individual Lightning Talk should last <u>no more than 5 minutes</u>.
- You may use slides to accompany your Lightning Talk presentation, although slides are not compulsory. If you do have slides you need to bring them to your session room on a USB stick before 8.45am on the day of your session. For any Mac users please be aware that the laptops at the conference venue are Windows laptops.
- Each Lightning Session will have a chair who will introduce the talks, keep speakers to time and facilitate the discussion.
- Before the end of May we will let you know of the other speakers in your session and the chair for your session.

Guidance for Poster Presenters

Instructions for uploading your poster to the Online Conference Portal:

- Log in to Oxford Abstracts website using the email address you submitted your poster abstract with: <u>Oxford Abstracts</u>
- Scroll down to the 'Submission' box
- Select edit this will open your submission in a new page
- Check your abstract, author and affiliation details and make any updates or corrections
- Scroll down to 'Poster Upload test'
- Select 'Chose file' and select your poster file. It must be saved as a pdf, be a single page and the file can be no larger than 10mb
- If you have a video or other associated resource, you can add this into the 'poster presentation link' box
- Add up to three key words that relate to the topic of your poster
- Click 'Submit'
